Hapa Zome (Leaf bashing)



WHAT YOU NEED

- Cloth or paper
- •A hammer (we couldn't find ours, so we used a rock!) You could also use a rolling pin
- •Hard surface to hammer on
- •Some flowers, leaves or other plants. Encouraging the kids collect the plants and colours they are drawn to.

WHAT YOU DO

- 1. Place the cloth or piece of paper on a hard surface (we used a log) Wooden chopping board works well.
- 2. Arrange the plant material on the fabric or paper.
- 3. Fold over the cloth or paper and have the kids start to hammer! If you want to protect the cloth more, you can put a piece of paper over it before pounding.
- 4. Open the cloth and remove the plant material.
- 5. Let dry.

To extend learning exploring creating symmetrical patterns. This can be linked to looking at symmetry in nature, such as butterfly.
